

Requirements to Remain in Scholars Program

Please read carefully and make certain that you comply with all of these requirements.

1. Be enrolled in at least one honors class.
2. Maintain an 85 overall average.
3. Report to scholars' classes on time and prepared (either by 8am, if in the morning, or 12:06, if at lunch).
4. Absences and late arrivals must be excused (allotted 2 excused absences).
5. Complete all homework without exception.
6. Meet deadlines and show up to meetings (especially senior projects).
 - a. If more than 1 deadline is "missed" you may be removed from the program.
 - b. If you consistently reschedule and miss appointments, you may be removed from the program.
 - c. Senior scholars MUST meet weekly to discuss the progress of their project.
 - d. Senior scholars must defend their project before a panel consisting of a faculty evaluator, a student evaluator, and the director of student research. In order to defend her/his project successfully, the student must receive a "pass" vote by all three members of the panel.
7. Failure to complete the end of course project or senior project will result in no credit for Scholars Program.
8. Any incident of cheating or plagiarism will result in immediate removal from the program.
9. If you elect, due to an illness or an excused reason, to drop out of the program, there is a possibility that you will be permitted to rejoin. If you are asked to leave the program, you will not be allowed to rejoin.
10. If you are put on probation, you will be contacted if you are eligible to rejoin in the next semester.
11. In order to complete the program and receive a Scholars' Diploma, you must:
 - a. Complete the required number of seminars based on your entry point
 - b. Complete all projects and assignments, especially the senior project
 - c. Choose a topic for your senior project that is approved and well done
 - d. Have good attendance
 - e. Be an active participant in class discussion
 - f. Put strong effort into your classwork and homework
 - g. Be free of any disciplinary or academic infraction
